CORE IDEA: To live Jesus.

FAMILY TIME!

Activity:

Take turns to imitate somebody in the family or a person who everybody knows. Everybody then have to guess who the person is. The person who is imitating can be saying words the person likes to use a lot or use a gesture or way of walking that is unique to the person.

Make a “Think before you speak” poster. Put it where everyone can see, read and remember it.

T- Is it true.

H - Is it Helpful.

I - Is it inspiring.

N - Is it necessary.

K - Is it Kind.

If you want to be a good example for all people, do it through what you say. Let your words be truthful, helpful, and kind. Live every moment for Jesus and follow His will.

TALK ABOUT IT

Discuss and create a Goal-setting plan for putting God first in your family.

- Start by having a discussion about the children’s goals and listen to their ideas as well as the things that your children feel they do well. Brainstorm these ideas on a chart or whiteboard. Encourage them and help them to recall how they went about learning those things.
- **Talk about priorities** - like what do you think is most important in life. Decide how and where you will spend time together as a family.
- Talk about acts of service you can do together! Examples include visiting the nursing home, volunteering in the community and to practice hospitality.
