TALK TOGETHER- PART 1

ITEMS NEEDED

Sanding paper cut into a squareWool









INSTRUCTIONS

 Draw a stone tablet on the back of the sanding paper. Cut it out as indicated on the picture.

Touch and feel the rough texture of the sanding paper. It's an unpleasant feeling just like sin in our lives that keeps us far from God. The rules on the backside was given so that God's people can know how to live close to Him.

Fold the bottom 2 corners of the table to the middle to form a heart. Cover the entire heart with wool.

TALK TOGETHER - PART 2

Jesus came to make all things new. Through His life and death on the cross he paid the price for all our sins. Jesus came to make the law complete. He kept every law in our place. Because of Him, we don't need the old law and rules to be close to God. We can now live close to Him even when we don't live perfect lives.
