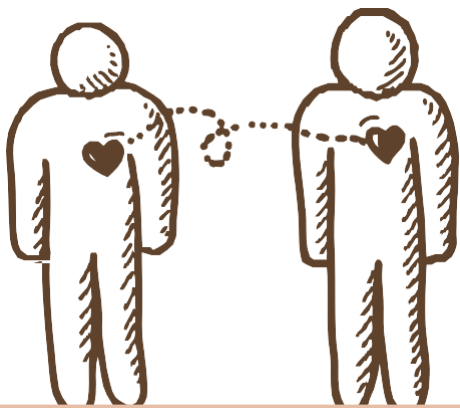

LET'S CHAT- PART 1

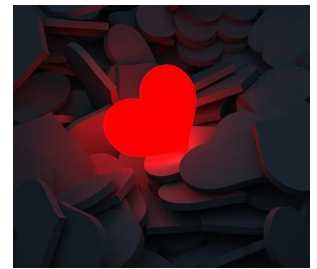
